Tour 1a:

Huertgenwald Museum - Kall Trail - Mestrenger Muehle - Simonskall (bunker/medical aid) - return to museum by shuttle buses.

Distance: approx. 8km

Duration: approx. 4-5 hours

Note: Level: ambitious, extreme inclination!
